Did you every have Pokemon cards? Baseball? In this assignment, you will create trading cards based on the people, events, inventions, or documents from Chapter 6. Try to create a card that you would WANT to play in a dangerous back ally trading card game.

Requirements:

- You will be required to make a minimum of 9 cards
- Card must be about 1) people, 2) events, 3) inventions, or 4) documents found in Chapter 6
- You must have a MINIMUM of 2 card topics per section (ex: 2 topics from 6.1, 3 from 6.3, etc.)
- Do NOT type a paragraph of text. This is NOT an essay. (see the examples)
- You can use sites like:pokemoncardmaker.org/ OR <https://mtgcardsmith.com/> OR Readwritethink.org
- Must have facts found both IN and OUT of the book. You'll need to do some research.
- Save each finished image as "last, first name CARD_topic" (ex: "jones, jim card rousseau")

Majority Vote

voting with as many as 1,500 people per assembly for or against someone's guilt of a crime provided an effective way of making decisions

Ostracise

Only usable on a political leader. Athen's jury can vote to banish the leader for up to ten years, only if the leader was gaining too much power.

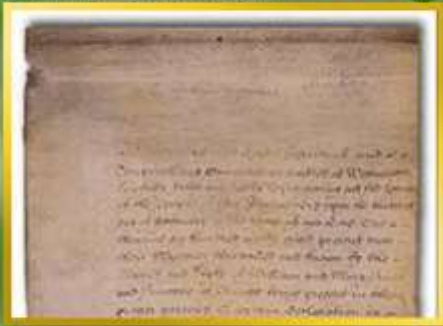

after the death of Jesus Christ, the Apostle Paul and other followers of Christianity spread the religion to most of Europe, around the Mediterranean, and northern Africa within 200 years.

any card with "Roman" anywhere on it adds +20 to the move "spreading religion" by first exiling Christians from their country, then later endorsing the religion and it's spread.

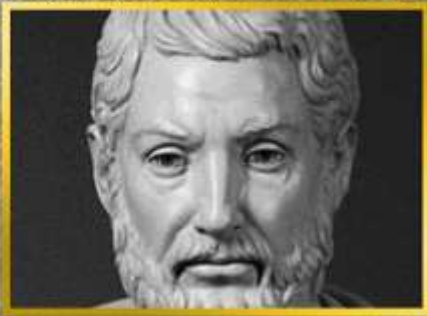

Balances the power of Rich and Poor citizens in the assembly; Allows citizens to submit laws for debate 60

🔥 Ignore Parliament
It works in James I's favor... but not for long. King James does 80 damage to himself 70

Cromwell becomes a military dictator. He increasingly authoritarian, damaging economy, and generating hatred towards himself.

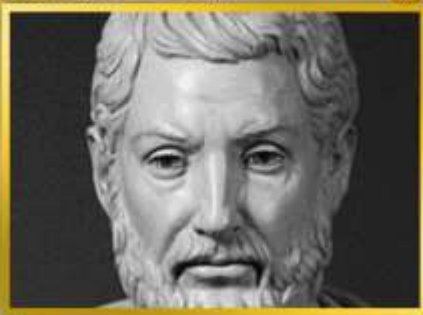

Direct Democracy

Pericles helps the formation of Direct Democracy, a form of government in which citizens rule and make laws directly. +20 by using "increase Paid Officials"

This action cancels the debts of farmers; helps to avoid Athenian Revolution or Civil war. Solon also promotes competitive commerce within Athens
